Virginia Essene will be in Tucson January 20-27 2007


Virginia will be presenting recent scientific evidence that suggests that among the brain's many contributions to life, its essential function is to develop a spiritual connection to the Creative Force of Life. It is the "hardware" of the soul or the neural equipment required to receive those helpful, higher vibrational frequencies we call consciousness. She will be using transparencies to explore what the brain looks like under major health conditions and discussing how malfunctions can be improved.

In addition, she will discuss the significance of the fact that the heart has an electromagnetic energy field 5,000 times greater than that of the brain. Neuroscientists have now discovered that there are over 40,000 nerve cells (neurons) in the heart, indicating that the heart has its own independent nervous system sometimes called "the brain in the heart."

She wants to encourage people's interest and concern for their body and brain - especially in the arena of child development and the exposure of the child's frontal lobes to light and love.

Virginia Essene, clairaudient, lecturer, and Minister, is president of the non-profit Share Foundation and created a publishing company under its auspices. She is also an author and co-
