Dowsing: the Base for Interdimensional Cooperation

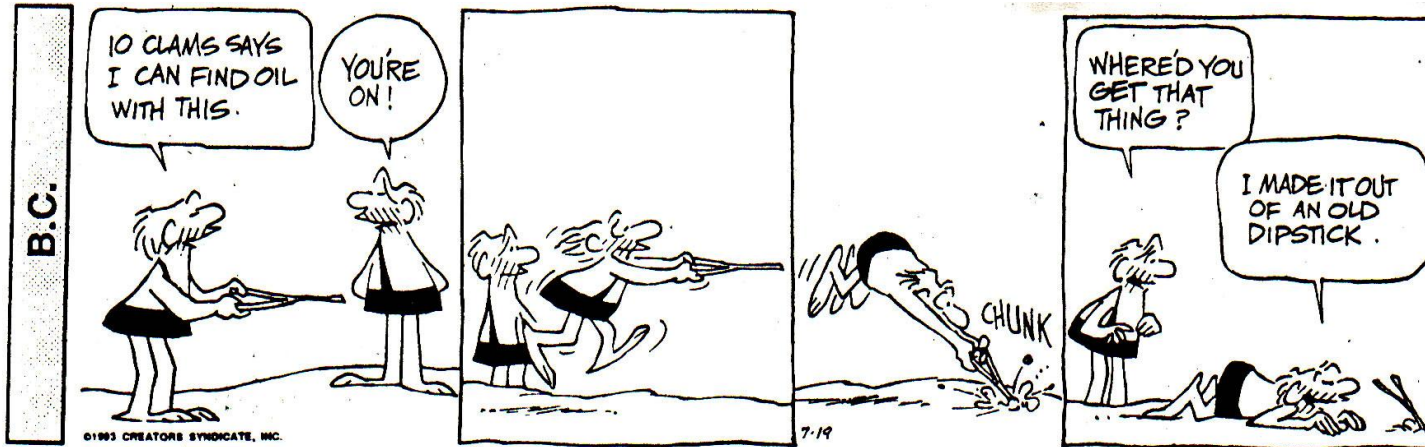
