Then it is up to all of us to implement these changes for the better in our lives. To use dowsing as a tool that helps us to make deci-

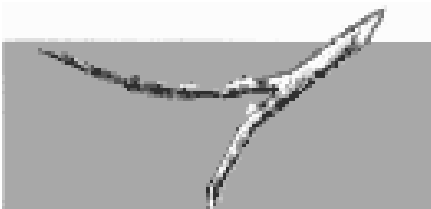

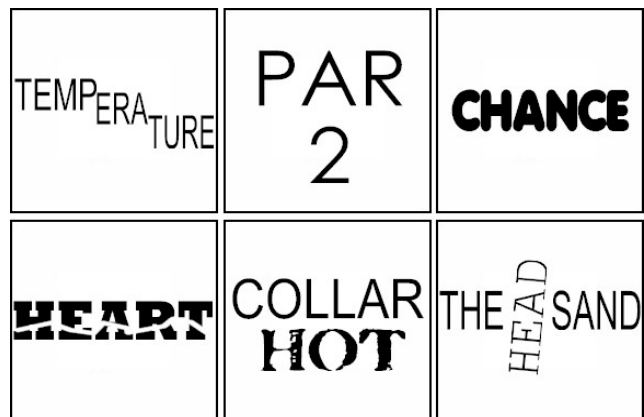
