

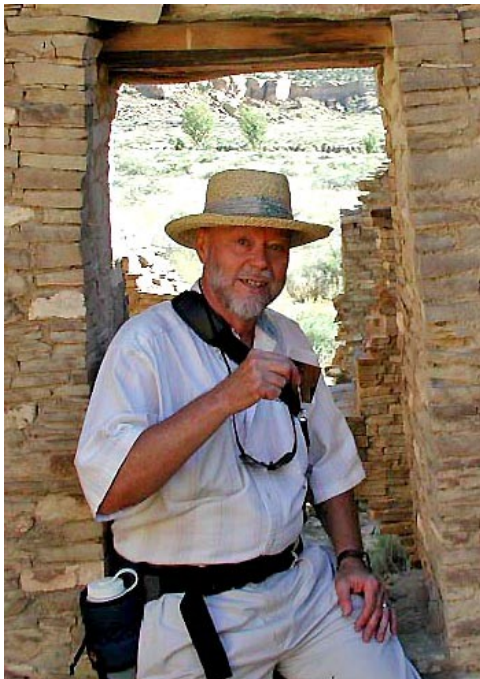

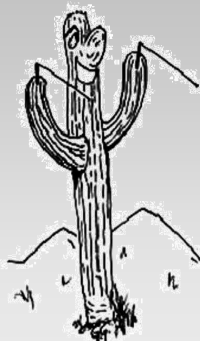
Notes from ASD SW Dowsers Conference

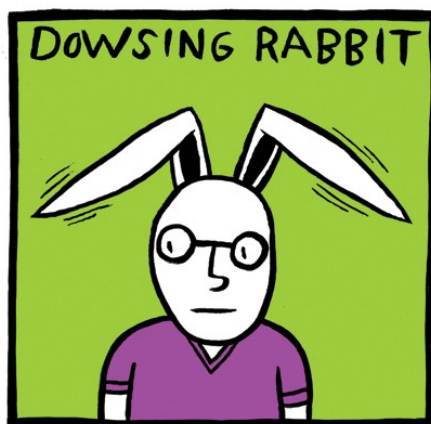
