## Advanced Pendulum Dowsing—The Eight Steps

1. *This is what I want to do.*  
(This is like turning on a radio.)
2. *Can I?*  
(Do I have the physical dowsing skills to do this?)
3. *May I?*  
(Do I have permission either from the person I am going to dowse for or from higher Spirit Guides who are looking out for me and who will keep me from getting in to trouble?)
4. *Am I ready?*  
(Is there anything else I should do before beginning to dowse? Have I got the questions phrased correctly? Is it time for me to know this answer, for example, “Does my Mother have cancer?” It might not be time for you to know this.)
5. *Ask the question.*
6. Now, here comes the place where most dowzers an mess up. I feel that the answers come up through our unconscious to our conscious mind. And our unconscious is eager to please and will give us the answer it thinks that we want to hear, for example, if your question is, “Does my Mother have cancer?” After asking the question you might well be saying to yourself, “Please God, let it be ‘No!’” So, of course, that is the response you’ll get regardless of the truth.

So at this point, think of the wild expectancy of a child as s/he inspects beautifully wrapped presents under a Christmas tree picking up one after another and shaking them and saying, “I wonder what’s in this one?” And “I wonder what’s in this one?”

So, after asking the question about your

Mother, say over and over, “I wonder what the answer’s going to be? I wonder what the answer’s going to be? I wonder what the answer’s going to be?” As long as you are asking that, your unconscious can’t get, “Dear God let it be ‘No!’”

7. *The answer*
8. And finally, “*Is this the Truth?*”  
Of course you want to know the answer to this one. If you want to continue dowsing on the subject, you do not need to go back to the first step. Instead go back to step number 5, and ask the next question and go on to 6, 7, and 8, and so on.

These eight steps will increase your accuracy as a dowser.

## Pass It On!

### Going on a Road Trip? Dowse It!

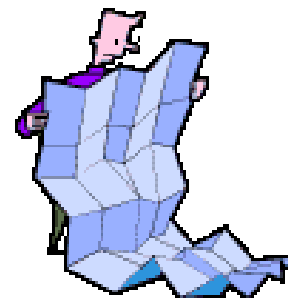

1. Get a map to and from your destination.
2. CLEAR YOURSELF
3. Put your finger (non-dominant hand) on the map on the starting point (usually Tucson)
4. Follow the route with your finger, ensuring that your pendulum is swinging in the “YES” position.
5. Follow the route you will be traveling and “IF” or “WHEN” the swing goes to the “NO” position, STOP!
6. CLEAR where the “NO” was indicated and stay there until the swing goes to “YES.”

I always take the “NO” swing as an obstruction to my trip, perhaps an accident, road work, car trouble, speed photo camera, etc.

7. Continue on your way, checking and swinging until you reach your destination.
8. Do the same map clearing on your way back home.

*Have a safe, trouble-free trip!*



#### No-Bake Party Mix Recipe

16 Servings

Prep time: 15 minutes

##### Ingredients

- 8 cups Crispix
- 2-1/2 cups miniature pretzels or pretzel sticks
- 2-1/2 cups miniature cheese crackers
- 3 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1 envelope ranch salad dressing mix

**Directions:** In a heavy-duty resealable 2-gallon Plastic bag, combine the cereal, pretzels and crackers; drizzle with oil. Seal and toss gently to mix. Sprinkle with dressing mix; seal and toss until well-coated. Store in an airtight container. Yield: about 12 cups (You can add nuts, or substitute two envelopes of Italian salad dressing mix for Ranch salad dressing mix.)

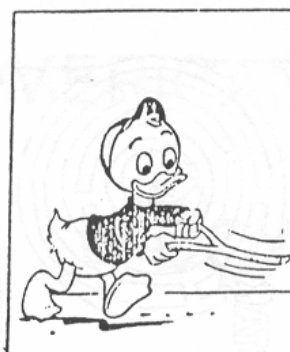


